Context:

Develop: ongoing awareness of new products, new methods, and new trends by researching a mixture of various sources; magazines, TV shows, websites, forums, blogs, galleries, exhibitions, crafts events, shops, workshops or other mediums.

Paper Craft: can be any form of paper craft design e.g. cards, scrapbook layouts, artist trading cards, parchment craft, quilling, sliceforms, 3D designs etc

Participate: Online Forums; at least three positive contribution to threads (including both initiate and respond), Magazines; regular submissions of letters (comments or questions), prefer at least one published submissions, but continual attempts would be acceptable.

Professionally Show Online: via forums, blogs, galleries etc, at least three posts with clear photographs and list of recipe details.

Professionally Show Offline: via magazines, galleries, exhibitions, shops etc, with recipe details. Prefer at least one displayed/published submission, but continual attempts would be acceptable.
